Improvements for order confirmation of scheduling agreements and scheduling agreement releases (CSC-23151)

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Introducing: Improvements for order confirmation of scheduling agreements and scheduling agreement releases

Feature Description

With this feature, the logic to retain previous confirmation when a new version of the scheduling agreement or scheduling agreement release is received has been improved. Now, when only the delivery date of the schedule line changes in the new version, confirmation is not retained. Hence, supplier must provide a new confirmation.

In addition, open quantities for confirmation are now downloaded at the schedule line level, instead of at item level. This change applies to scheduling agreements and scheduling agreement releases as well as to regular orders. As a consequence, confirmation process is simplified.

Finally, two new columns have been added to the order confirmation Excel template: Requested Quantity and Need by Date Audience:

1. Logic to Retain Confirmation

A. New **business rule** to **retain confirmation** for **SA/SAR** when a **new version** of the document is received:

Retain schedule-line confirmations in a new version of a scheduling agreement or scheduling agreement release.

- B. Current logic: when a new version of the SA/SAR is received, previous confirmations is always retained, except when:
 - The schedule line is **dropped** in the new version of the SA/SAR (confirmation is not retained for the dropped schedule line).
 - The schedule line **quantity changes** in the new version of the SA/SAR (confirmation is not retained for this schedule line), unless there's a confirmation status that matches the schedule line's **quantity** and **date**.

NEW BEHAVIOR:

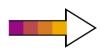
• The schedule line quantity and/or delivery date changes in the new version of the SA/SAR (confirmation is not retained for this schedule line), unless there's a confirmation status that matches the schedule line's quantity and date.

1. Logic to Retain Confirmation

Example 1:

1. Buyer sends SAR and supplier confirms it AS-IS

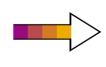
SL1 quantity/date have not changed → confirmation is retained

SL2 delivery date has changed → confirmation is NOT retained

2. Download open quantity for confirmation at Schedule line level

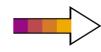
<u>Current problem</u>: Confirmation process through Excel for unconfirmed quantities is cumbersome today because after an item has been confirmed or partially confirmed, open quantities for confirmation are downloaded at line-item level (instead of at schedule line level).

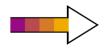

2. Download open quantity for confirmation at Schedule line level

- If supplier confirms an item **partially**, when supplier downloads data for confirmation to Excel, each **unconfirmed** or **partially confirmed schedule line** must display the **remaining quantity** to be confirmed.
- Two new columns have been added to the order confirmation Excel template: Requested Quantity and Need by Date.
