- SAP Ariba releases a number of features on quarterly basis across the Ariba Solution Portfolio
- In most cases, Ariba Customers are not able to keep track of these releases or understand which of these new innovations might be useful for addressing their current pain points

Enabling history records for enriching requisition data in external systems [CP-21901]

Target GA: 2302



Enabling history records for enriching requisition data in external systems [CP-21901]

Description

- For sites that are configured for external validation and enrichment of approvable data, this feature enables history records for changes made to requisitions by external systems while enriching the requisition data.
- SAP Ariba Procurement solutions allow the export of some requisition data to an external system for processing, including validating the data and enriching it if needed. The enriched data received from the external system is automatically updated in the corresponding fields in the requisition.

Customer benefit

Previously, there was no indication shown to users that the data has been enriched. Now, when this feature is enabled, users can view these changes in the history records.

Prerequisites, restrictions, cautions

Prerequisites

- Your site must be configured for external validation and enrichment of approvable data.
- The Application.Purchasing.AllowRequisitionEnrichment (SAP Ariba Support enabled) parameter must be enabled.
- Your administrator must configure the Process Requisition Externally web service integration task, to send the requisition data to external systems to be validated and enriched.
- Your administrator must enable the Enable history records for enriching requisition data in external systems (Application.Procure.ValidateEnrich.Requisition.EnableHistoryRecordsForEnrichment) parameter.

Cautions

When you click the Check button while composing a requisition, the data is sent to the external system for validation and enrichment. Then, the enriched data received from the external system is updated in the corresponding fields and a history record is created for the changes. Any further changes that you make to the enriched data while the requisition is in the composed state are not captured in the history.

Improved design for finding requests

Customer challenge

When a casual user creates a number of requests, acts in a team or requests on behalf of others, it can be difficult to find certain requests quickly and easily.

Description

The Your Requests search pages have been redesigned to display:

- Different document types in different tabs for simple navigation
- Recently updated requisitions and purchase orders are displayed on Recent requests tab
- Requisitions and purchase orders now have enhanced filtering capability by supplier, status, updated timeframe along with document IDs and sort options
- Requisitions allow for search by requested-by options: self, on behalf of, and team
- Requisitions allow for WBS/Project accounting object search

Customer benefit

- This feature improves transactional search capability with enhanced filtering for casual users in guided buying
- Improved transactional visibility for on behalf of and team buying scenarios

Description

- This feature enables you to view the names of suppliers in requisitions on the **Requisitions to Approve** screen of the SAP Ariba Procurement mobile app.
- For requisitions that have items from multiple suppliers, a See all link is displayed which when clicked displays the list of the other supplier names.

Customer benefit

- This feature helps you prioritize the requisitions you want to review based on the suppliers.
- This information will reduce the approval TAT for requisition approvers.

Prerequisites, restrictions, cautions

Prerequisites

- You must download the latest version of the SAP Ariba Procurement mobile app to your mobile device and have the required sign-in information.
- You must belong to the Ariba Mobile User group to use the SAP Ariba Procurement mobile app.
- You must belong to the Mobile Shopping group to use the shopping cart feature unless the site is configured to bypass the group membership check for the Mobile Shopping group.
- Your administrator must enable the "Enable display of supplier details on Requisitions to Approve screen in the SAP Ariba Procurement mobile app" (Application.Mobile.EnableDisplayOfSupplierDetailsOnRequisitionsToApproveScreen) parameter to use this feature.

Feature details

- 1. View the names of suppliers in requisitions on the **Requisitions to Approve** screen.
- 2. A **See all suppliers** link is displayed for items with multiple suppliers.
