What does it do?

Supplier Data API with Pagination allows you to retrieve and update information about your organization's suppliers. Such as:

- Registration details
- Questionnaires and certificates

Who can use it?

- SAP Ariba Supplier Information and Performance Management
- SAP Ariba Supplier Lifecycle and Performance

What can you find in this API?

- Endpoints for getting supplier data
- Multiple endpoints for fetching questionnaire data in different ways
- Multiple endpoints for fetching data about specific question answers within questionnaires
- An endpoint for fetching header-level data for all of a supplier's certificates
- An endpoint for setting questionnaire data in registration, qualification, and modular supplier management questionnaires
- Multiple endpoints for managing process projects


Security and Authentication


- Auto enabled within 24 hours of it's creation.
- OAuth Token expires every 24 min. (1440 sec.) and must be refreshed.
- Each API call retrieves data for a single site


Are there Limits on the data that can be fetched?

There are two types of limits in SLP API:

- > Rate Limit The number of API calls made every second/minute/hour/day may not exceed a certain limit
 - Current Rate Limit (Requests): 3/second, 150/minute, 4500/hour, 25000/day
- Pagination Limit The number of results per page returned based on query parameters and endpoint used




PATCH

SLP working

- SM Database will have details stored under vendors
- Vendor registration / process details along with basic vendor details are stored in a separate database.
- API fetches data from SM database through GET methods
- You can also update vendor data via API and that gets reflected in Sourcing UI
