Enhancements to SAP Ariba Contracts Integration with Icertis Contract Intelligence for SAP Ariba Solutions

Description

- This feature allows users to create/update/amend an Icertis Agreement directly from an Ariba Awarded Event and manage the lifecycle of contracts on the Icertis Contract Intelligence platform (ICI).
- Sourcing agents will be able to view the associated contract created and/or updated against the sourcing event so that they understand the existing contract and evaluate the need of any new contract.

- Customers that use Ariba Sourcing can automatically create Icertis Agreements based on an awarded sourcing event in Ariba. This provides companies



Feature details

- Users can:
 - create an Agreement in Icertis Contract Intelligence for SAP Ariba Solutions from a Guided Sourcing Event
 - add awarded line items from a Guided Sourcing Event to an Existing Agreement in Icertis Contract Intelligence for SAP Ariba Solutions
 - create a new Agreement in Icertis Contract Intelligence for SAP Ariba Solutions from a sourcing event
 - add awarded line items from a sourcing event to an existing Agreement in Icertis Contract Intelligence for SAP Ariba Solutions
- After the sourcing event has been awarded the system automatically creates an Agreement in Icertis.
- An Ariba Contract Workspace gets triggered as soon as the agreement is created at Icertis.
- The Create Line Items Document (CLID) gets updated before approval.

Screenshot 1: Trigger Contract Creation




Screenshot 2: Navigation Link to Agreement in Icertis

User story

- 1. On the monitor page of SAP Ariba Sourcing, you go to the Award scenarios Scenario Maker tab.
- When you click the more actions icon (vertical three dots) that appears next to the name of the awarded supplier, you can select 'Create a contract for awarded items'.
- If contracts associated with the sourcing event exist, a popup informs you about the existing contracts. Click 'Ok' to proceed with the contract creation. Another popup appears with a disclaimer message.
- Click 'Ok' on the popup.
- 5. You are redirected to the ICI user interface to create an agreement. The Create Agreement page appears for the first step of the agreement creation process.
- Complete all the steps in the agreement creation process.
 - For information about creating an agreement in ICI, see <u>Creating Agreements in ICI</u> Information published on non-SAP site.
- After the agreement is created, ICI creates a corresponding contract workspace in SAP Ariba Contracts.
- 8. You can find the new contract workspace linked to the event in guided sourcing. The contract workspace also shows the Icertis ID associated with it.
- 9. You can click the Icertis ID to view the agreement details in ICI.
