Support for Resending Failed Service Sheets from SAP Ariba Solutions to SAP Business Network [ACSS-1219]

Support for Resending Failed Service Sheets from SAP Ariba Solutions to SAP Business Network [ACSS-1219]

- Buyers can use this feature to enable SAP Ariba solutions to initiate the resending of service sheets in the Processed state that failed to reach the SAP Business Network (e.g. if the SAP Business Network is down)
- The History tab will show a respective status:
 - Successfully sent
 - Failed
 - Permanently failed (which indicates that the SAP Ariba solution will not attempt to resend the failed service sheet again)
- Your administrator must enable the parameter "Enable resending of failed service sheets to SAP Business Network "

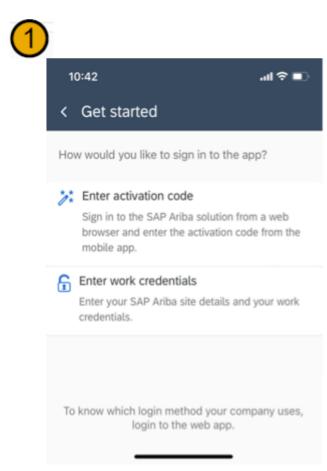

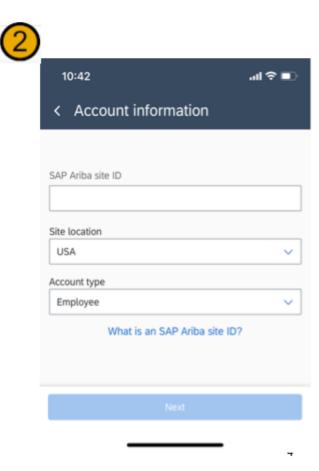

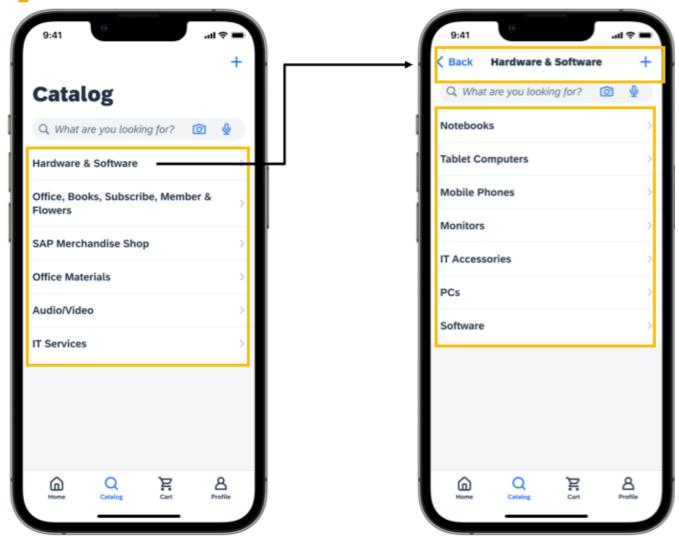


Enhanced Shopping Section, Approval Workflows in SAP Ariba Procurement Mobile App [BMA-4890]

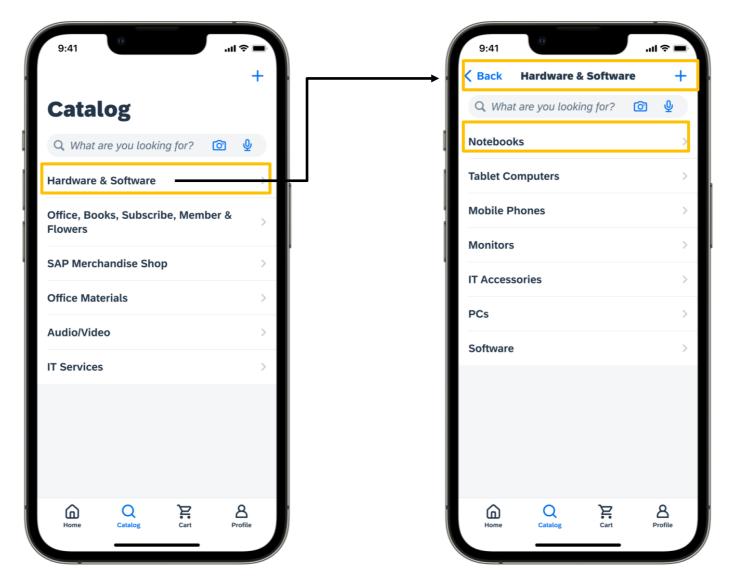
- SAP Ariba Procurement mobile app users can use the enhancements related to
 - viewing saved carts, viewing the last requisition that the user was creating,
 - creating requests for non-catalog items,
 - searching for catalog items in the Shopping section on the home screen
- Users can also view the approval details for their tasks, requisitions, and supplier onboarding requests, with less scrolling.
- The Saved carts card is removed. The Requisitions tile in the Your requests section now also displays saved carts that are in Composing state.
- A shopping cart icon with item count is displayed next to the search icon that indicates
 the most recent requisition the user was creating.
- The Request a non-catalog item option in Shopping categories is removed. To create a non-catalog item request, users can use the Non-catalog item tile

View and Browse in Categories in SAP Ariba Shopping Mobile Application [SAS-38]

- Items in the catalog are divided into categories and sub-categories within which the user can view and browse for items
- These categories make viewing and browsing for items easier and provide a more manageable way to find items in a catalog with a large number of items.

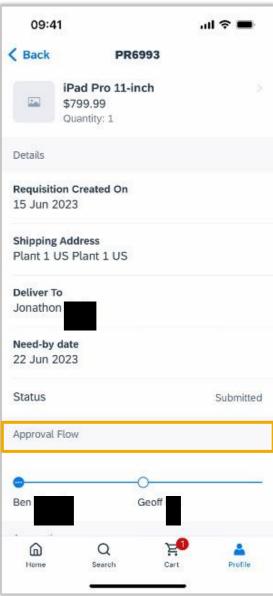

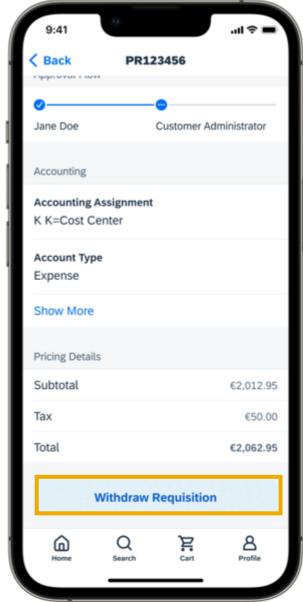
Approval Flow Preview in SAP Ariba Mobile Shopping Application [SAS-54]

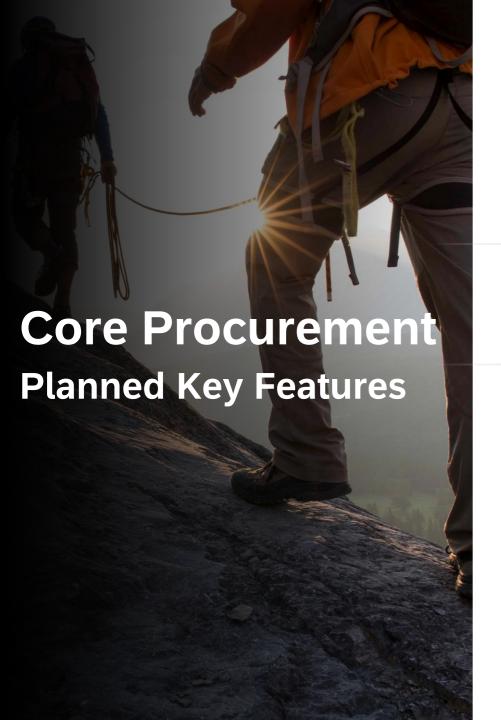
- With this feature you can configure your approval flow logic in SAP Ariba, which is displayed in SAP Ariba Shopping's Requisition details screen
- In the current preview mode, only two nodes are displayed, the current node and the upcoming node
- If the approval flow of the requisition contains parallel nodes, the approval flow is not displayed



Withdraw Requisitions in SAP Ariba Shopping Mobile Application [SAS-56]

- This feature enables users to withdraw purchase requisitions that are in Submitted and Denied status
- After a user submits the purchase requisition, they can navigate to the details area where the Withdraw button is available.
- Tapping this button changes the status to Composing and the purchase requisition can then be modified and resubmitted





Core Procurement Updates

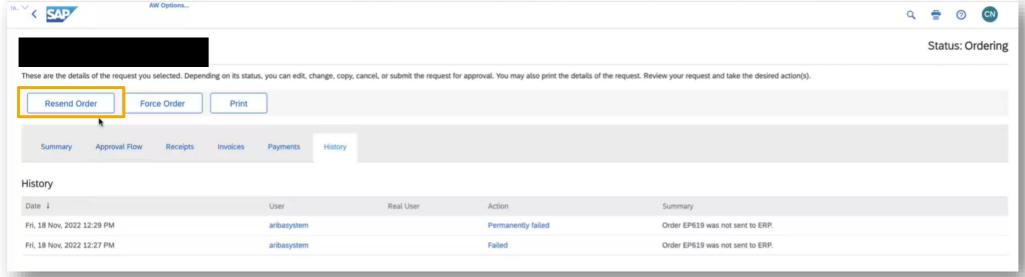
Enhanced Resending of Stuck Purchase Orders [CP-19278]

One must belong to the **Purchasing Approvable Resend Administrator group** to view and use the **Resend Order button**.

Clicking the **Resend Order** button only marks the order for resend and it is not resent immediately.

This button is displayed only in the following scenario:

- The hours since the purchase order was created exceed the hours specified in the Set hours to enable resending of stuck purchase orders (Application.Purchasing.SetHoursToEnableResendingOfStuckPurchaseOrders) parameter.
- The purchase order is still being sent, or if sending has permanently failed.



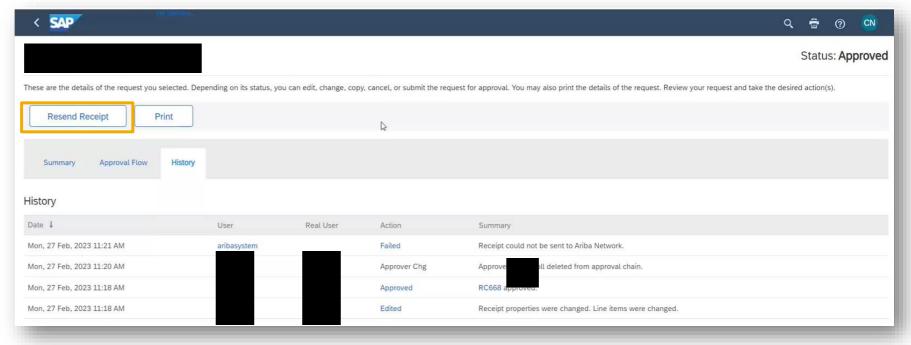
Support for resending receipts stuck in sending or failed state to SAP Business Network [CP-22890]

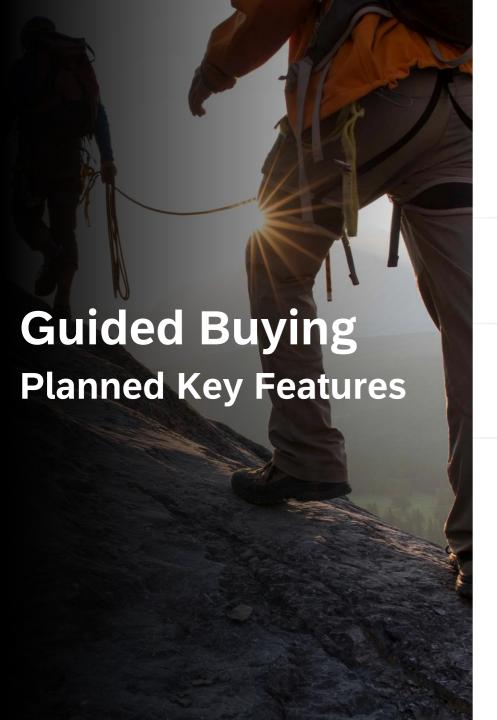
Users who belong to the **Purchasing Approvable Resend Administrator** group can resend receipts that are stuck while being sent to SAP Business Network. If sending the receipt takes too long, or if sending fails, you can use the **Resend Receipt** button to manually initiate an attempt to resend.

This button is displayed based on the number of hours specified in the Set hours to enable resending of stuck receipts to SAP Business Network

(Application.Purchasing.SetHoursToEnableResendingOfStuckReceiptsToSAPBusinessNetwork) parameter.

For example, if the parameter is set to the recommended value 24, the button is displayed 24 hours after the receipt sending is initiated, if the receipt is still being sent, or if the sending has failed.

Sending spot buy items in guided buying requests to SAP S/4HANA or SAP S/4HANA Cloud (2NV integration scenario) [GB-17635, GB-20422]

- Sending Spot Buy items, e.g. from Mercateo Unite or Amazon Business, from Guided Buying to SAP S/4HANA in the Intelligent Enterprise Suite (IES) integration scenario (2NV) is now possible
- This includes the support of PO and Invoice collaboration via the SAP Business Network (42K)
- Note: handling and managing Spot Buy line items does have certain restrictions to "normal" Guided Buying" line items, e.g. there is no "Buy again" option, copying of a Spot Buy line item, etc.

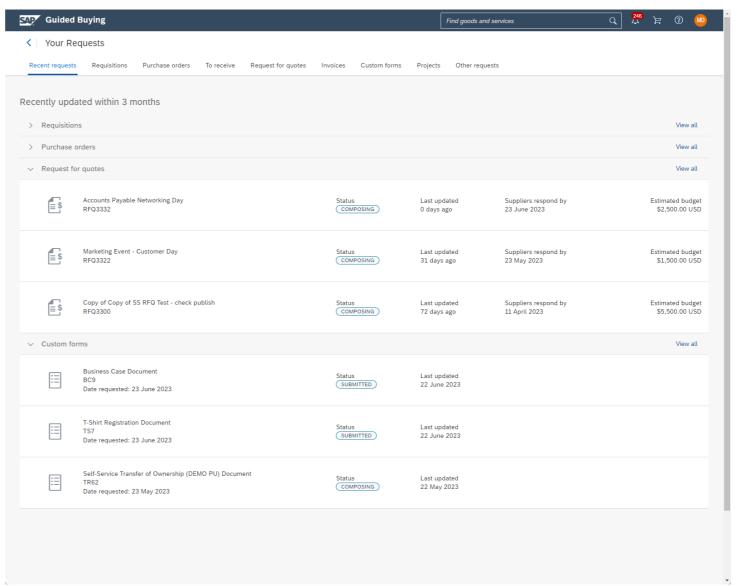
Improved Search in Request for Quotes and Forms [GB-23278]

- This feature improves search capability with enhanced filtering for casual users in guided buying
- Improved transactional visibility for custom forms and request for quotes
- the Your Requests transactional search pages for have been redesigned to display improved filters and sort options for:
 - Request for quote (RFQ) documents
 - Custom forms
- Requisition search has also been enhanced to allow for WBS/Project accounting object search based on parameter enablement
- The parameter "PARAM_ENABLE_ENHANCED_YOUR_REQUEST_2" needs to be set to "true" to leverage this improved search

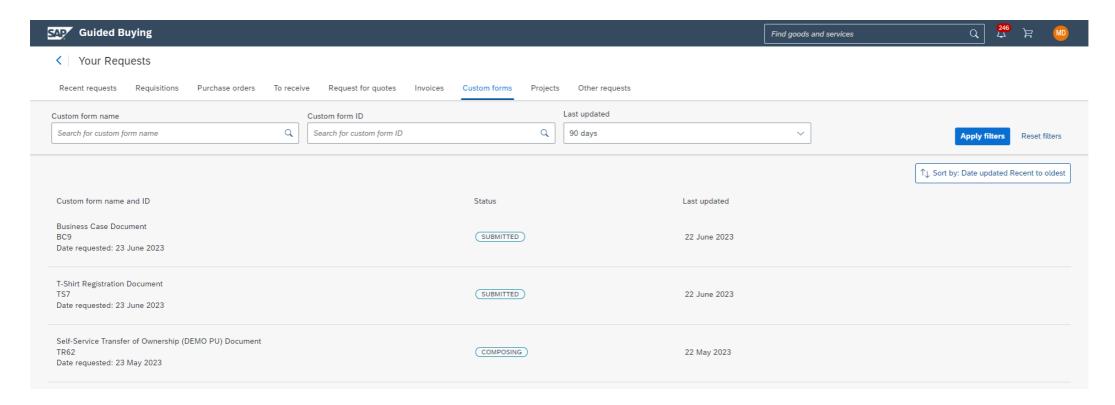

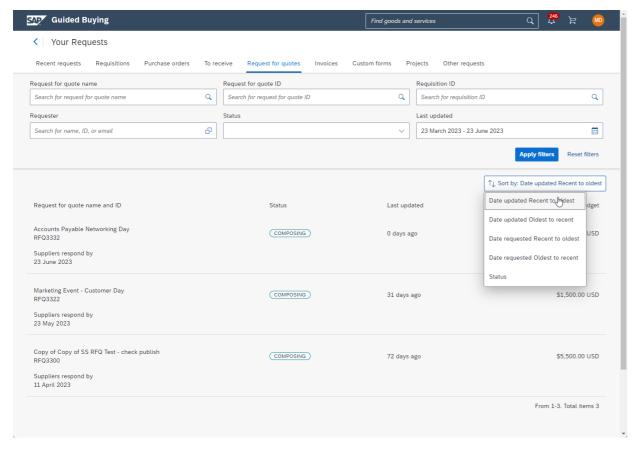

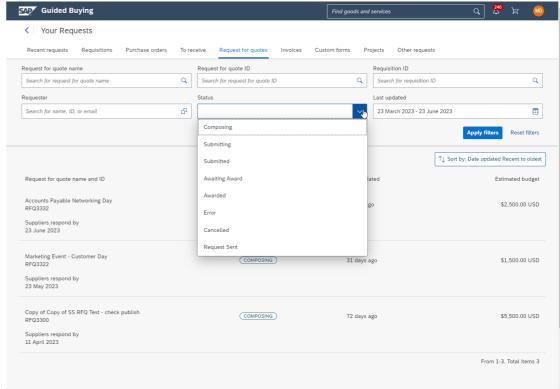

- Sort by date requested, updated or by Status

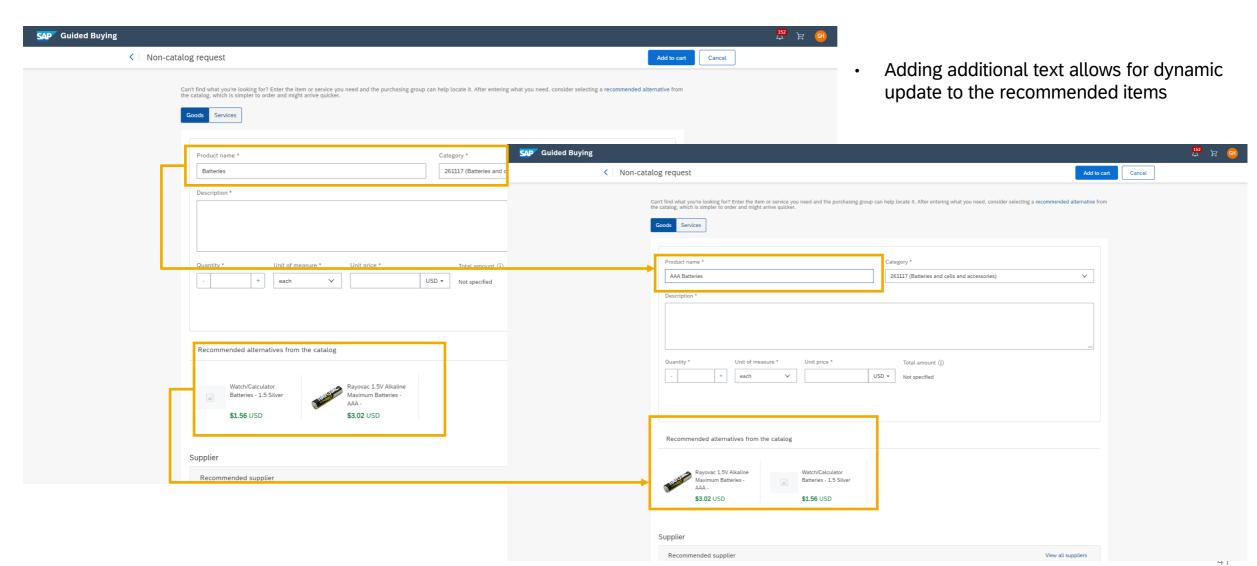


3 Recommended Alternatives for Non-Catalog Items [GB-23280]

- As users enter the name of an item, the carousel updates recommendations dynamically using artificial intelligence and machine learning
- Reduce unnecessary non-catalog requisition approvals and spend
- Guide user behavior when creating non-catalog items using historical search data relevant to their current request

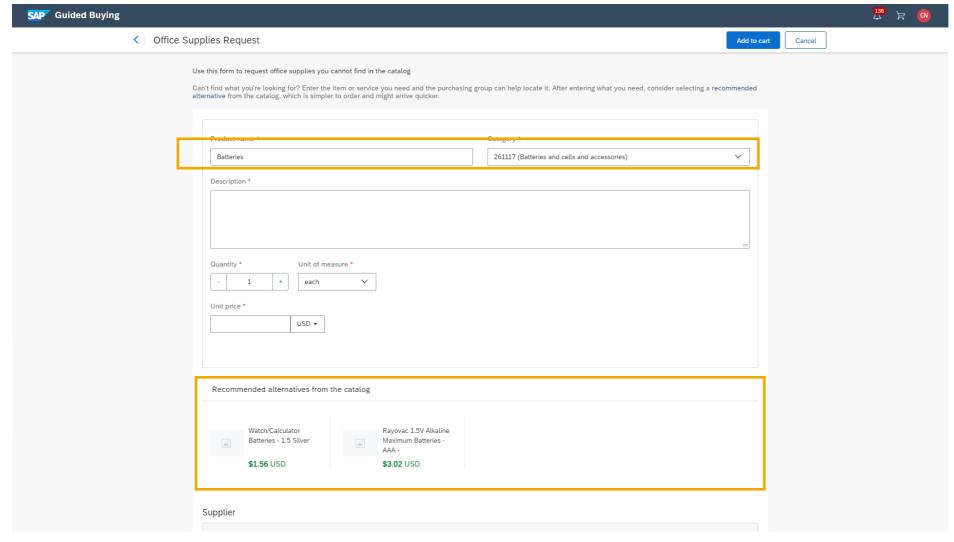

Requisition forms can also be configured to display recommendations based on user input



SAP Central Invoice Management on SAP BTP provides a unified solution for receiving and managing supplier invoices, with connection to multiple systems, such as SAP S/4HANA Cloud systems.



SAP Central Invoice Management Updates

Invoice Clearing Status [INV-292]

Document Information Extraction of Payment Reference [INV-386]

Alternative OCR solution integration [CIM-371, CIM-395]

Invoice Clearing Status [INV-292]

- When an invoice is cleared in the connected SAP S/4HANA Cloud system, this information will also be displayed in SAP Central Invoice Management.
 - In case a posting has multiple vendor line items and only some are cleared then the invoice is marked as "Partially cleared".
 - Only when all vendor line items are cleared, then the status "Cleared" will be set.
 - If an invoice is blocked (payment block set), this is also displayed in the clearing status.
- The clearing status is available as:
 - Filter criteria for the invoice list
 - In the invoice list as column
 - As header information in the detail view

Benefits:

- Increases transparency of clearing status
- Enables better monitoring and tracking of open invoices
- Provides a basis for efficient supplier communication

Document Information Extraction of Payment Reference [INV-386]

- "Payment Reference" is used in multiple countries (mainly Nordic countries like Sweden, Norway,...) to transfer a key to the customer in the invoice. The customer should include the payment reference when making the payment.
- The payment institution will include this key in the bank statement for the customer and seller, allowing for clearing of payments using this key. This key creates a link between the bank statement items and the invoice.
- The "Payment Reference" field is now extracted by Document Information Extraction service (OCR) and transferred to SAP Central Invoice Management.

Benefits:

- Helps full automation of invoices in Nordics (Denmark, Finland, Norway Sweden)
- Reduce manual efforts for accountants

3 Alternative OCR solution integration [CIM-371, CIM-395]

 APIs that allow partners to connect their OCR services to the inbound processing module of SAP Central Invoice Management as an alternative to the Document Information Extraction service

Benefits:

- Provides flexibility with regards to the application and integration of alternative OCR solutions
- Offers enhanced support for invoices that are currently not supported by our OCR engine

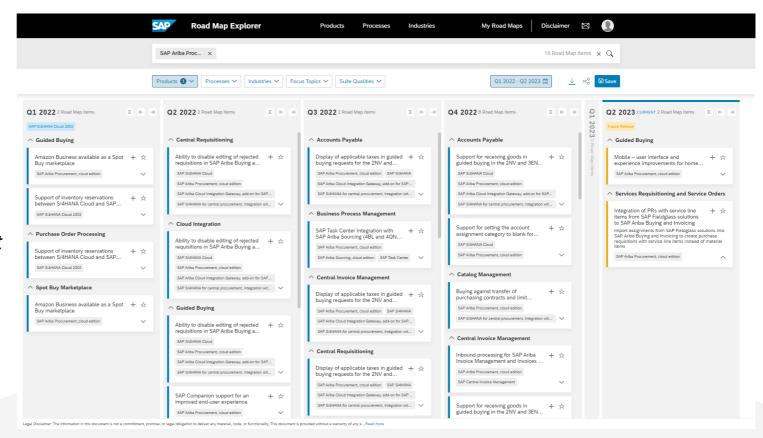

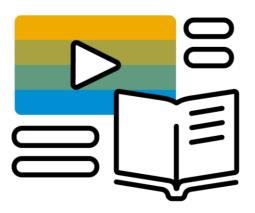

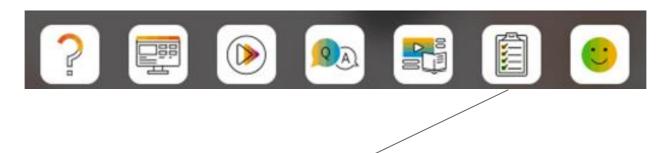
