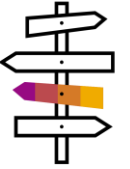
Prerequisites

- Advanced Packaging feature of Business Network for Supply Chain is enabled

Restrictions

- Default packaging instruction are not supported yet for the automated exchange via S/4 API

User Story



Default Packaging Instructions are only showing up in case no specific packaging instruction is available for an material to be packed. If customer want to offer the supplier default packaging instruction in addition as an alternative option, this is not possible today.

As also limiting the default packaging instruction e.g., to a specific plant or vendor ID is not supported.

Feature Details



This feature provides more options for buyer to offer default and specific packaging instructions for handling units to suppliers

Allow to show default packaging instruction in addition to specific assigned ones

- Enables the option to show multiple specific and default packaging instruction to the supplier at same time
- All instructions offered in same dropdown list on define instruction screen

Add support for assignment fields for default packaging instructions in excel upload

- Enables Assignment tab support for default packaging instructions
- Support of all related determination fields like:
 - Plant
 - ANID
 - Vendor ID
 - Validity Period
