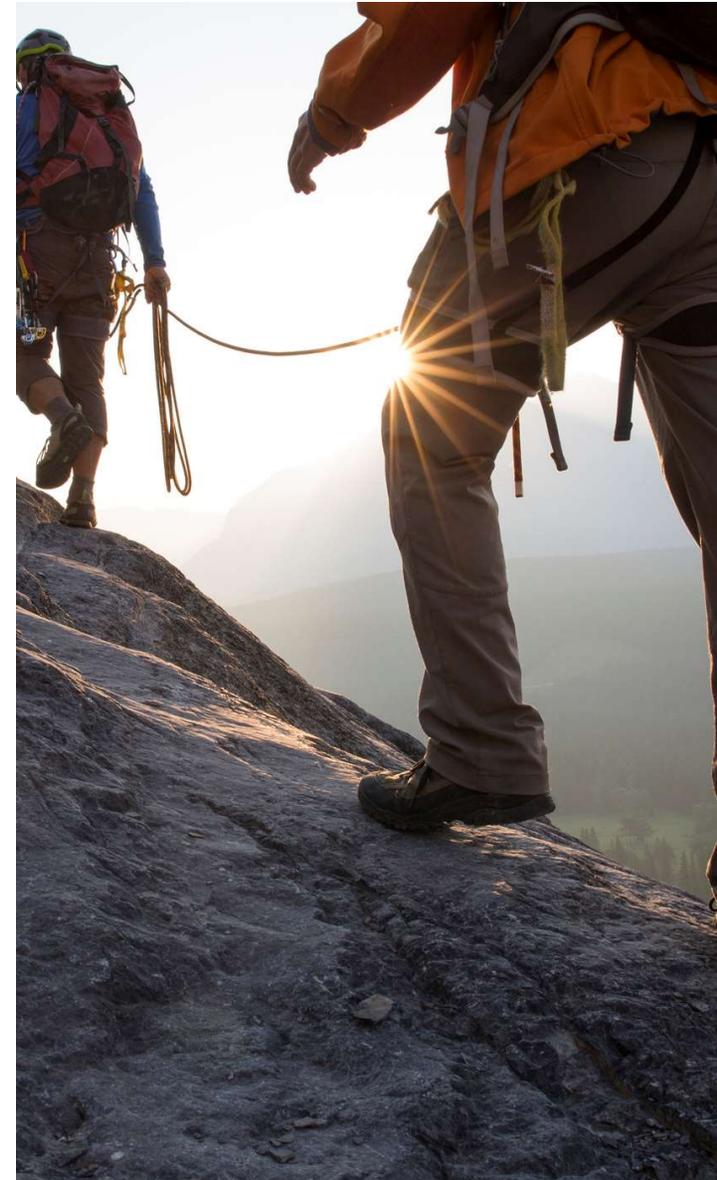

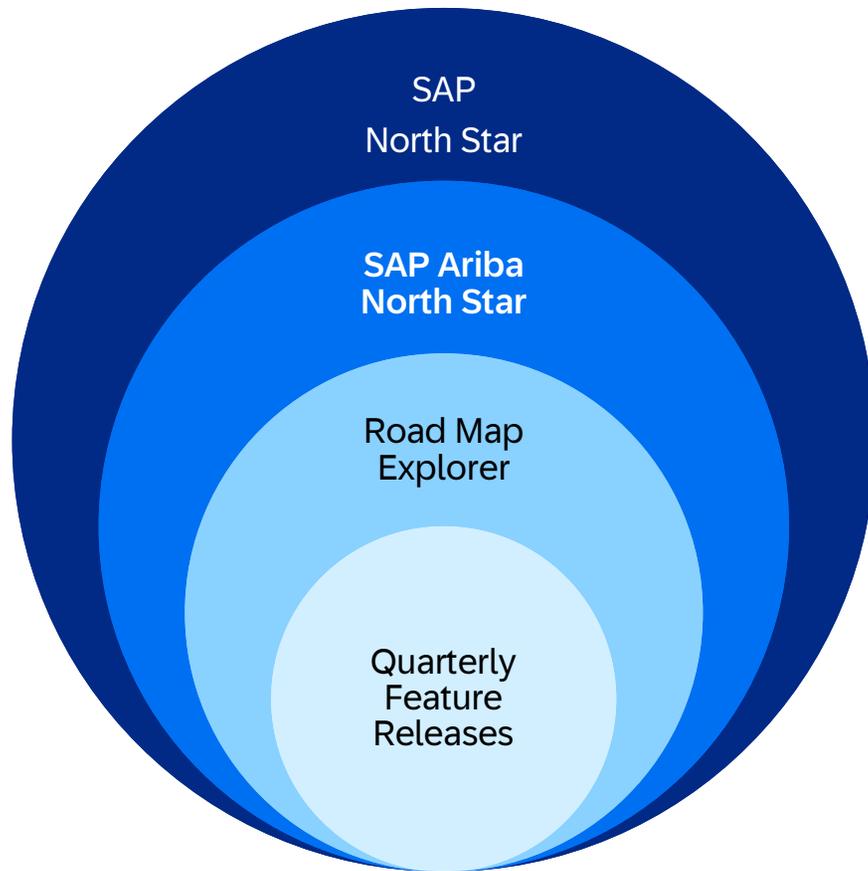

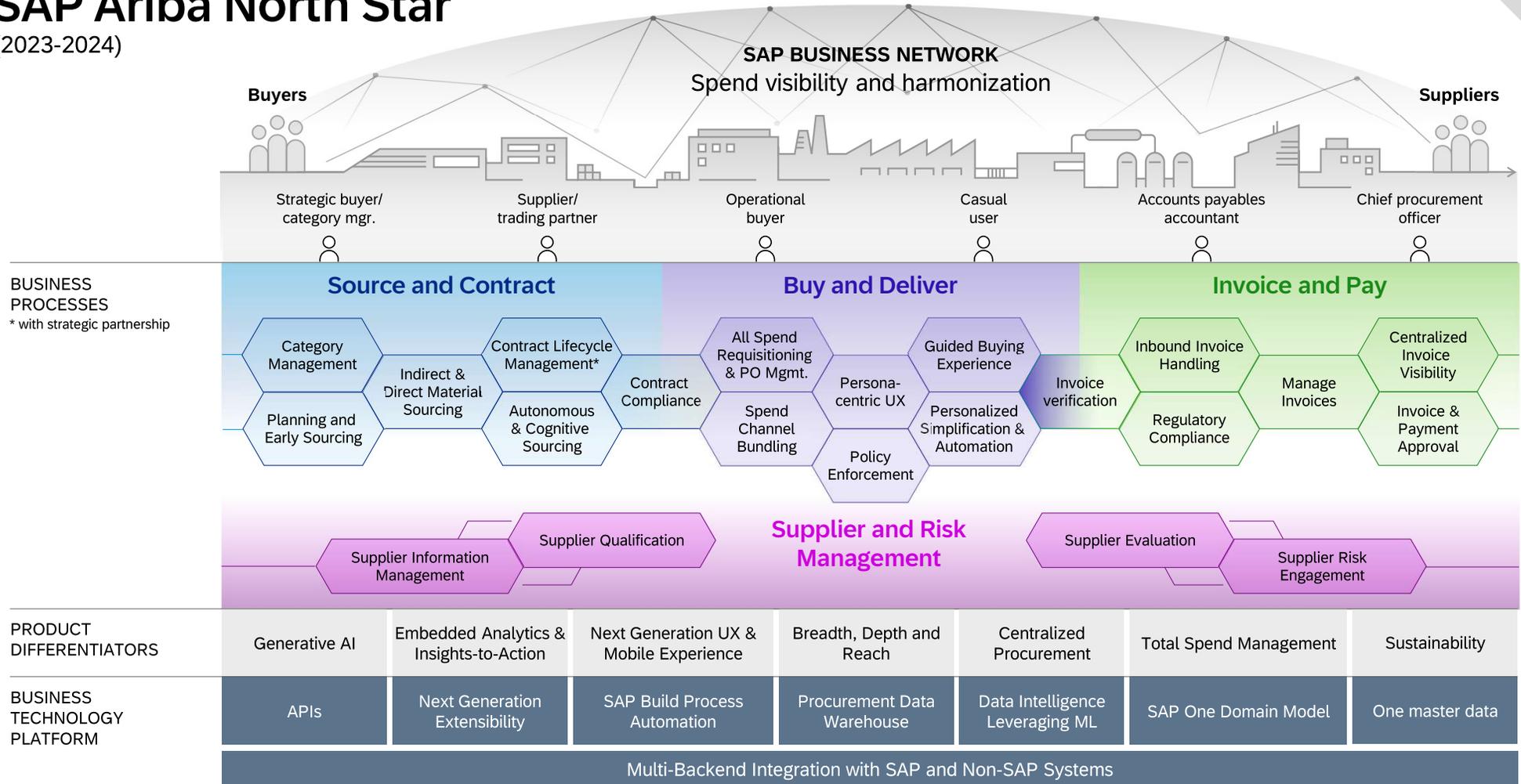


Our North Star vision sets our product’s long-term goals, while the **Road Map** is a breakdown of actionable steps toward these goals.

**Quarterly feature releases** are the incremental innovations in the Road Map, ensuring consistent progress towards achieving our North Star vision.

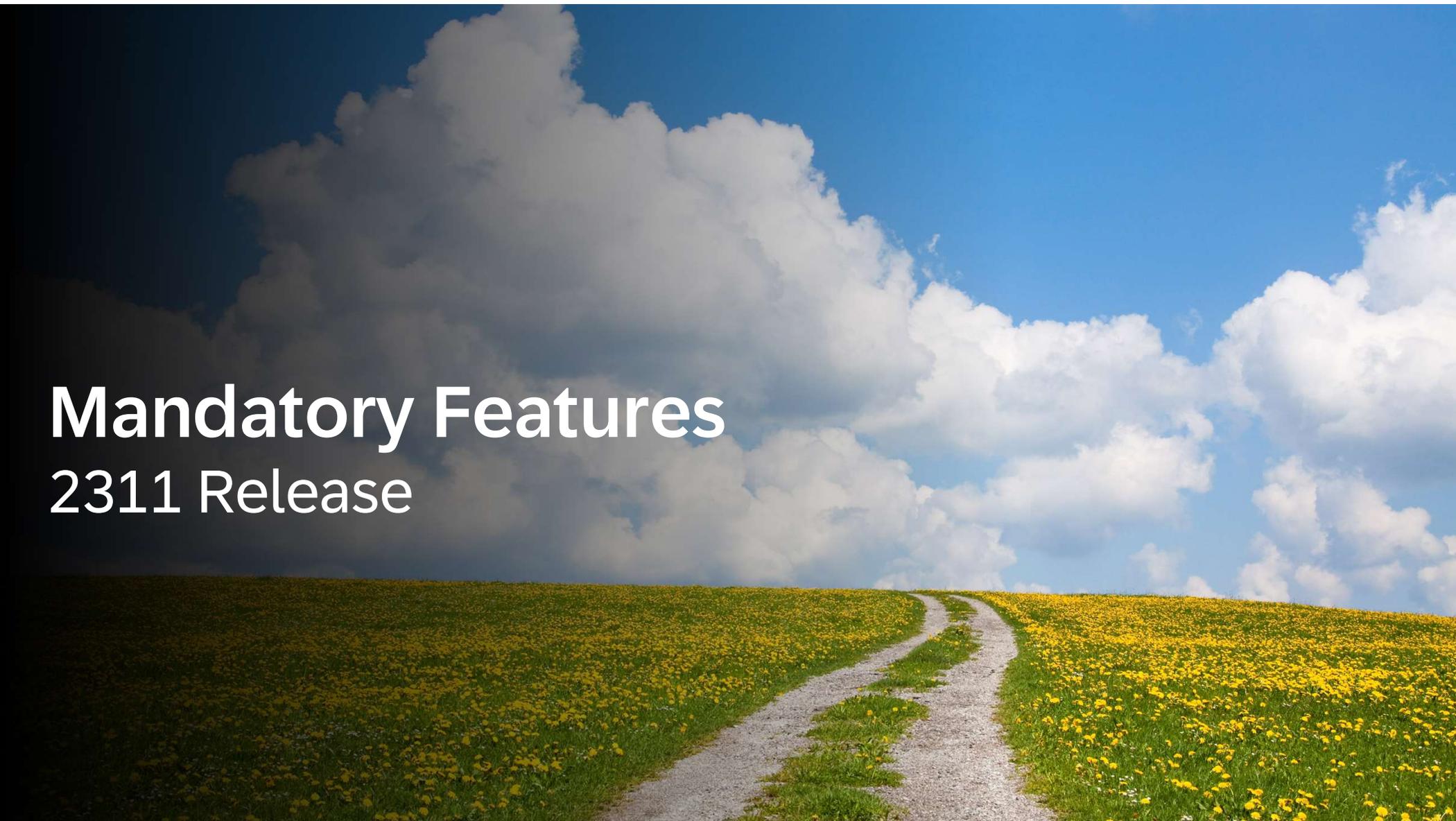

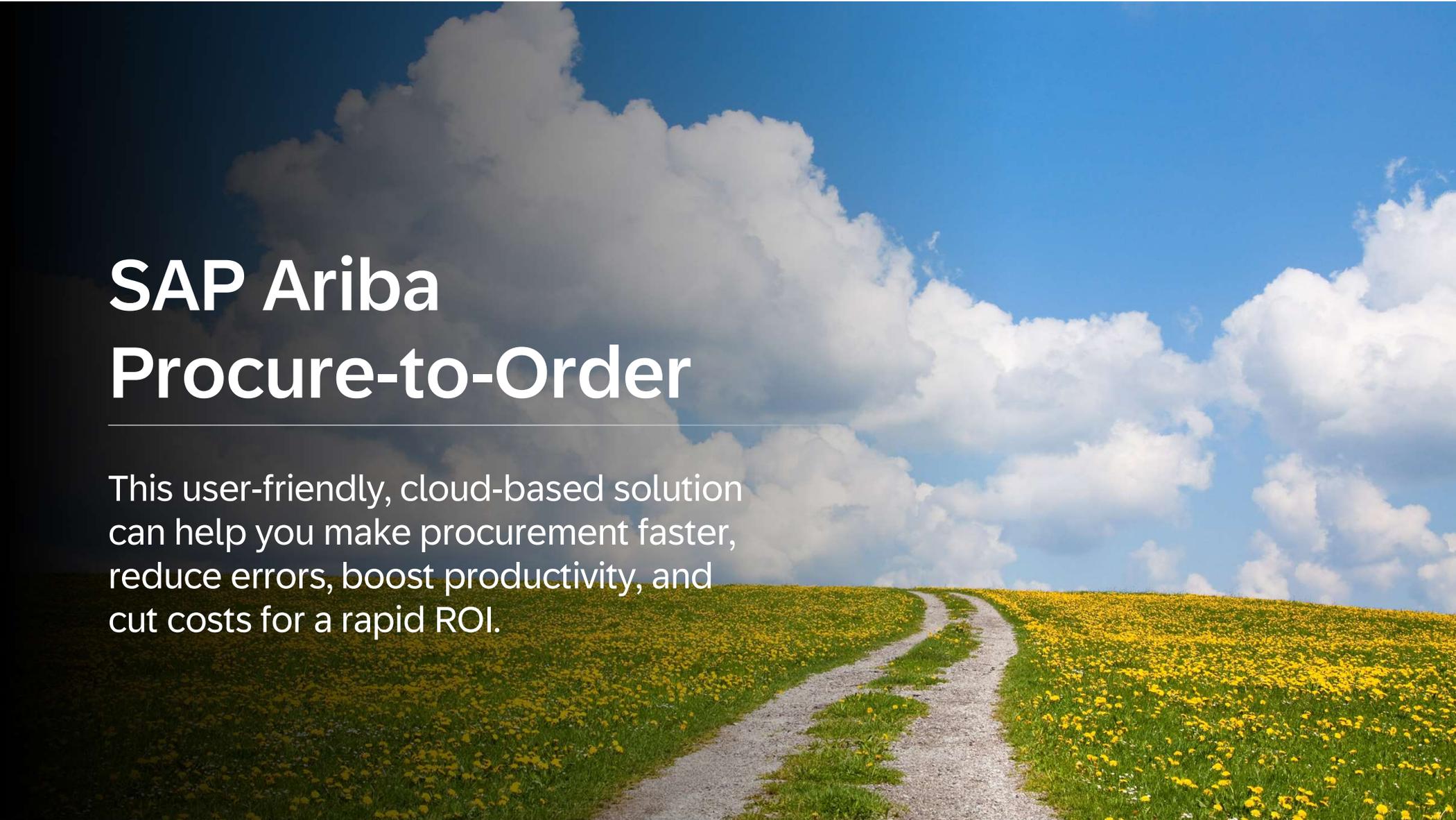

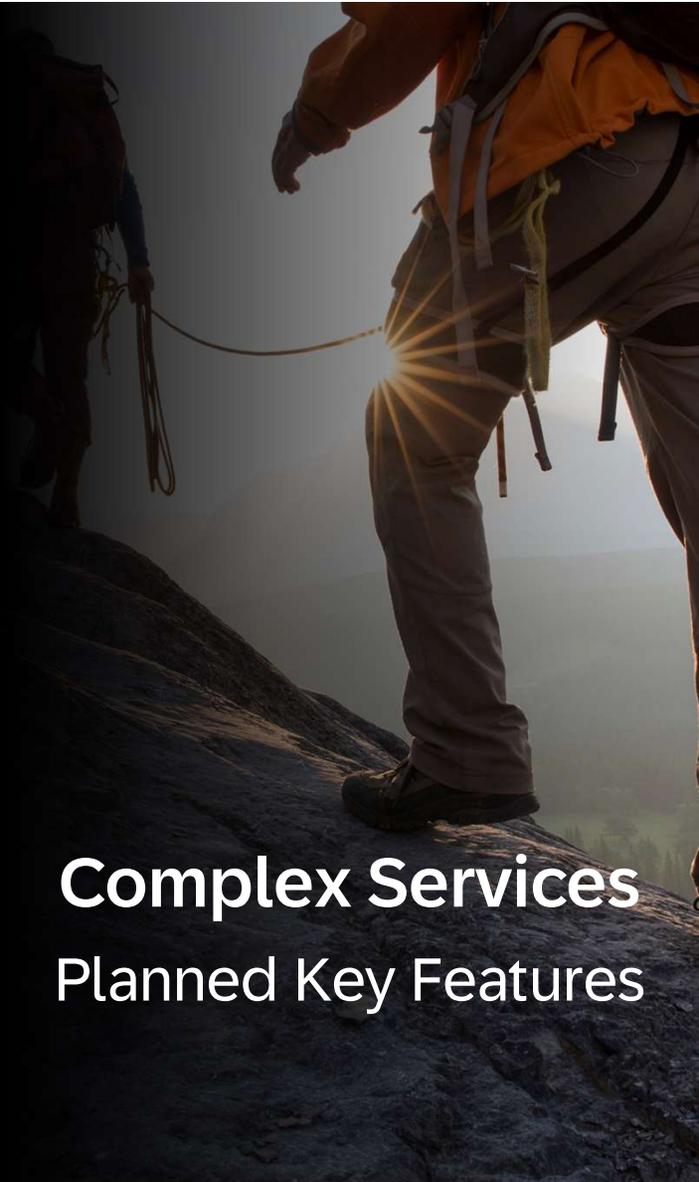

## Usability Enhancement for Creation of Standing Orders for Limit Items in Guided Buying [\[ACSS-1241\]](#)

- For buyer sites that create standing orders for limit items (item category B) in guided buying, the standing orders checkbox in the request can be configured to be deselected by default for catalog items.
- This feature requires the guided buying capability.
- Enable the `DISPLAY_DESELECTED_CHECKBOX_STANDING_ORDERS` parameter in guided buying. The parameter determines whether the checkbox for standing orders is deselected, by default, when adding limit items (item category B) from the catalog. If set to true, the checkbox is deselected and the item is procured as a non-limit item. If set to false (default), the checkbox is selected and additional fields related to standing orders are displayed.

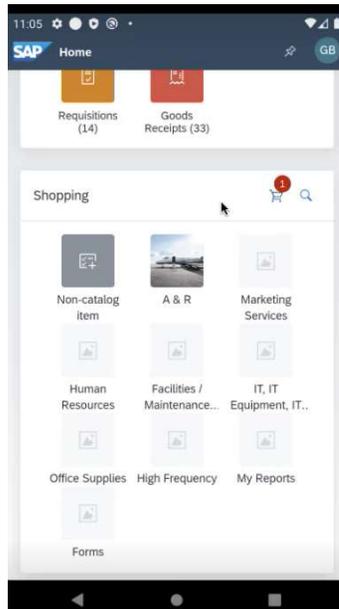

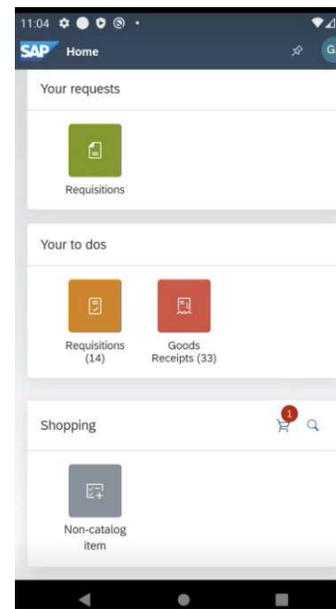
## Option to Hide Non-Catalog Shopping Categories in SAP Ariba Procurement Mobile App [BMA-5091]

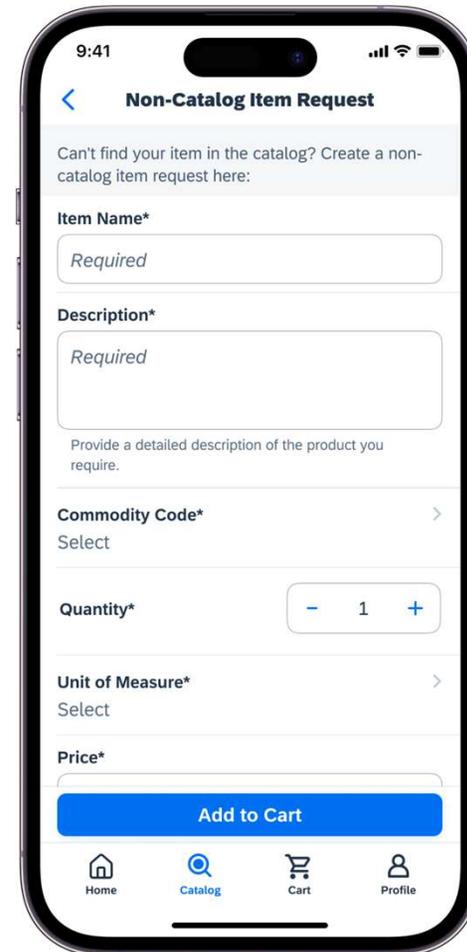

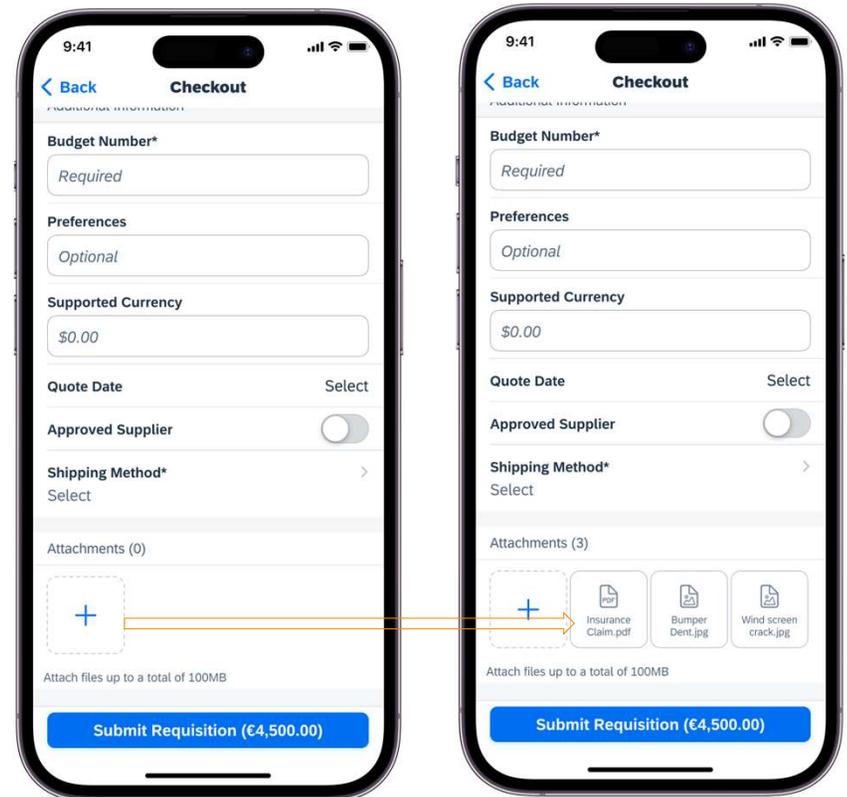
## 2 Adding Non-Catalog Items to Requisitions in SAP Ariba Shopping Mobile App [SAS-55]

- With this feature, users can add non-catalog items to their requisition and submit a purchase requisition that has a non-catalog item as a line item.
- The user can add the non-catalog item to the cart by creating a new purchase requisition or adding it to an already existing purchase requisition.



# 3 Adding Attachments to Requisitions at Header Level in SAP Ariba Shopping Mobile App [SAS-59]

- With this feature users can add attachments to their requisitions at the header level.
- 25 file types and a total of 100MB per requisition
- Upload, download and delete attachments is possible in Composing status, before it is submitted

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# 1 Support for Resending Multiple Purchase Orders and Receipts [CP-19875]

Purchase orders and Receipts may be stuck in Ordering or Cancelling state due to various reasons while sending them from the SAP Ariba solution to SAP ERP or SAP Business Network.

- Buyers can now initiate resending multiple purchase orders and receipts that appear stuck in the SAP Ariba solution.
- These issues were previously managed by SAP Ariba support involving root cause analysis followed by the associated fix. With this feature customers can now initiate the resend directly.
- Prior to sending make sure the purchase orders or receipts do indeed not exist on the Network.

# 1 Support for Resending Multiple Purchase Orders and Receipts [CP-19875]

- Use the **Manage -> Resend Approvable**
- Purchase Orders or Receipts that are longer than a configurable amount of time in the status Ordering or Cancelling are being displayed and can be resend.

## 2 Using SAP Ariba Standard Functionality to Send the Date Received Field to External Systems [\[CP-23579\]](#)

This allows to send the receiving date of line items in a purchase requisition (the Date Received field) to SAP ERP and other external systems using the receipt export file.

- The details of the receipt, such as the date of generation of the receipt (EventDate) or the date on which the receipt was fully approved (ApprovedDate), are sent to SAP ERP or other external systems regularly using the receipt export file.
- No need to contact SAP Ariba Support anymore to request customization

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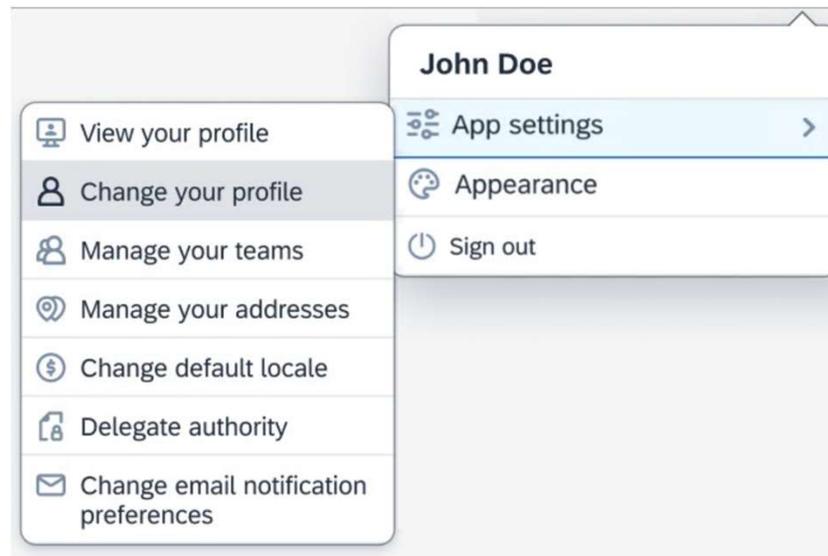

# 1 New Settings Option in Guided Buying [GB-19085]

This feature organizes user profile settings into a new option in the user menu: **App settings**. The App settings option contains the same options that were previously available, but is now a more consistent cross-product experience.

- When you select App settings, all the profile options display, as shown:

## Synchronized Status Changes for Guided Buying Requests Edited in SAP S/4HANA or SAP S/4HANA Cloud in the 2NV and 3EN Integration Scenarios [\[GB-21591\]](#), [\[GB-24956\]](#)

In the guided buying capability with SAP Ariba Buying (2NV) integration scenario and the guided buying for Central Procurement with SAP Ariba Buying (3EN) integration scenario, this feature enables buyers to:

- View the updated status changes in guided buying for requests that are rejected in SAP S/4HANA [\[GB-24956\]](#) or SAP S/4HANA Cloud [\[GB-21591\]](#).

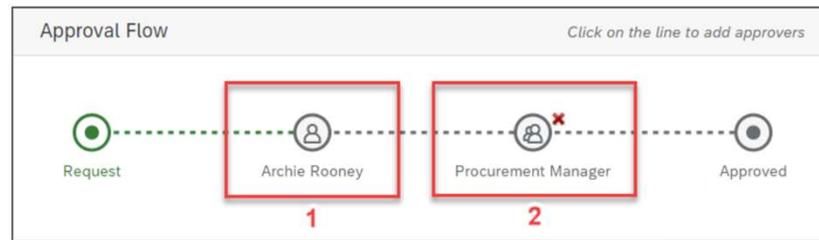
After a request is sent from guided buying to SAP S/4HANA or SAP S/4HANA Cloud, it goes through status changes such as partially approved, approved, partially rejected, rejected, and so on.

- The request can be edited further in SAP S/4HANA or SAP S/4HANA Cloud after it has been rejected.
- When it's edited, the status of the request changes and this change is synchronized and displayed in guided buying.

# 3 Support for Adding Groups to Requisition Approval Flows in Guided Buying [GB-24299]

Guided buying users can add user groups to approval flows when they create purchase requisitions.

- New icons in the approval flow show whether an approver is an individual user or a group



1 = Individual User, 2 = Group

- Upon approval, the icons change color: a green check mark for "Approved" or a red "X" for "Denied"



## 3 Support for Adding Groups to Requisition Approval Flows in Guided Buying [\[GB-24299\]](#)

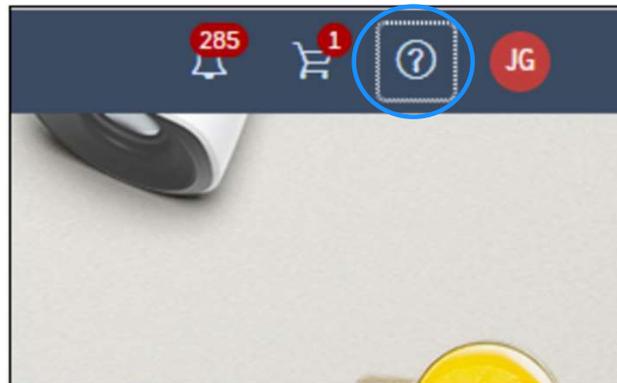
This feature is optional in this release. In the future, SAP Ariba plans to turn it on for all customers.

- When this feature becomes mandatory SAP Ariba will remove the existing parameter named `ENABLE_SHOW_APPROVER_GROUP_MEMBERS`, which determines whether guided buying displays the individual members in groups.
- Then, the visibility of group members will be determined solely by group definitions in SAP Ariba Procurement solutions.
- Restriction: Groups can be added to purchase requisitions only, not to other document types, such as forms or invoices.

# 4 SAP Companion Enabled for All Guided Buying Users [\[GB-24309\]](#)

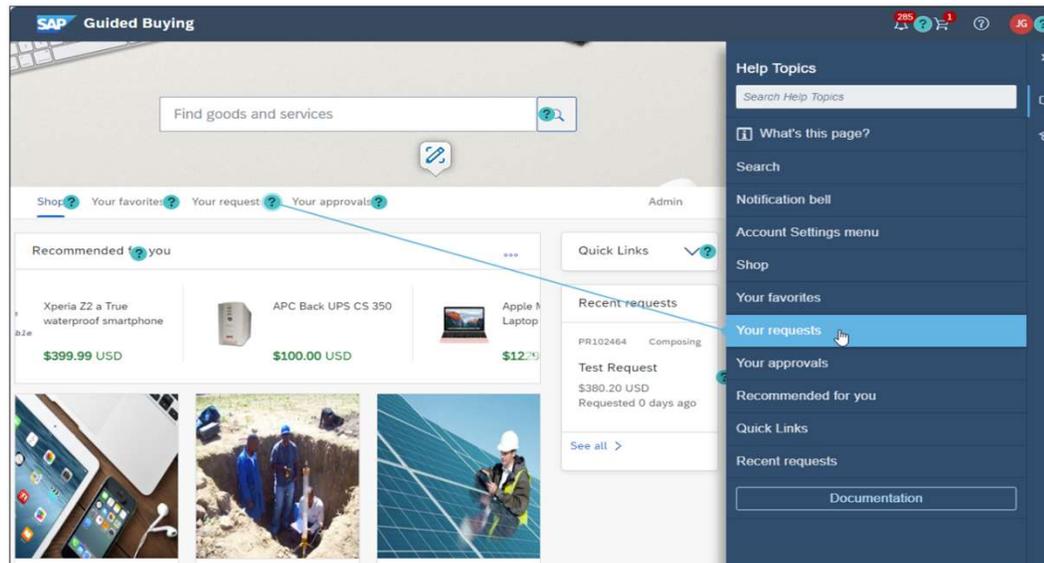
The SAP Companion help and learning platform is now **turned on** for all guided buying users.

- It comes with standard help content and tutorials.
- To modify help topics and add new content an SAP Enable Now license is needed.
- SAP Companion adds a question mark icon (?) to the right-hand header of the guided buying window.



# 4 SAP Companion Enabled for All Guided Buying Users [GB-24309]

- When you click it, the SAP Companion panel slides in from the right.
- Help topics on the right connect to individual UI elements in the guided buying page.
- Users can click the mortarboard cap on the far right to start guided buying tutorials.



# 5 Require Administrators to Configure Secure URLs [\[GB-24620\]](#)

To ensure that connections are more secure, guided buying no longer accepts "http" URLs configured by administrators.

- All new URLs added to the configuration must start with "https", which is a secure version of the HTTP protocol.
- When administrators change the configuration, guided buying checks for non-secure URLs.
- It checks URLs entered by administrators in:
  - The targetUrl and imageUrl attributes in landing page Excel and JSON files.
  - The Target Url fields within External Site tiles when editing landing pages in the landing page designer.
  - The Link field in announcement tiles.

# 5 Require Administrators to Configure Secure URLs [GB-24620]

- When administrators open the landing page designer, guided buying detects any non-secure URLs in External Site tiles and displays errors in affected tiles. All new URLs added to the configuration must start with "https", which is a secure version of the HTTP protocol.
- Administrators must edit those tiles to use secure URLs before they can save them.



- Guided Buying detects any non-secure values in targetUrl and imageURL attributes in Excel or JSON files

## Receipt of invoices from SAP Business Network [CIM-543]

- This feature can be configured by the customer
- SAP Business Network allows the direct electronic exchange of invoices between suppliers and customers including validations.
- This integration allows to receive invoices directly from SAP Business Network and to trigger the invoice processing in SAP Central Invoice Management, inbound processing module.

### Benefits:

- Receiving of electronic invoices
- Increase automation of invoice processing
- Reduce manual efforts for accountants

# 2 Legal networks integration [CIM 400], [CIM-215]

- This feature can be configured by the customer
- Receive invoices from Peppol into SAP Ariba Central Invoice Management, inbound processing module through an integration with SAP Document and Reporting Compliance service.
- Supported receiver country: Germany and Norway

## Benefits:

- Compliant invoice receipt according to legal requirements of specific tax authorities.
- Reduced effort of invoice processing through e-invoicing

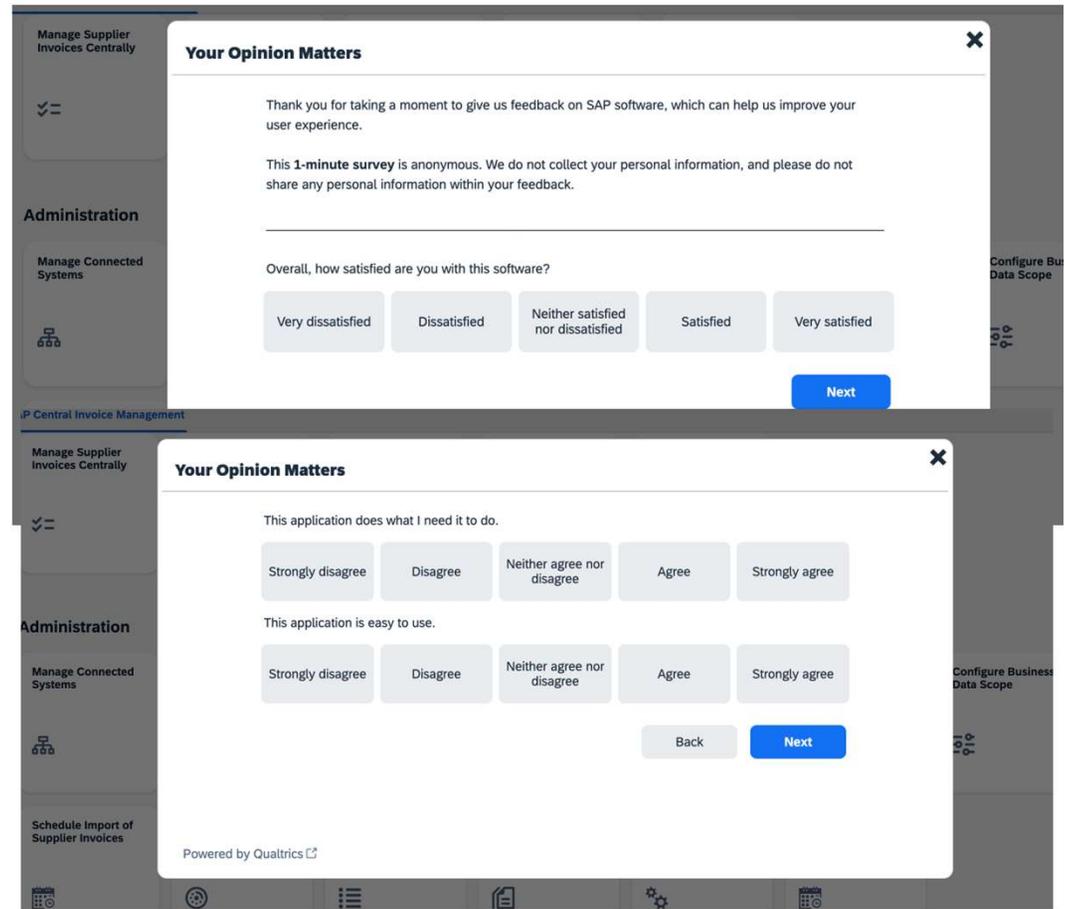

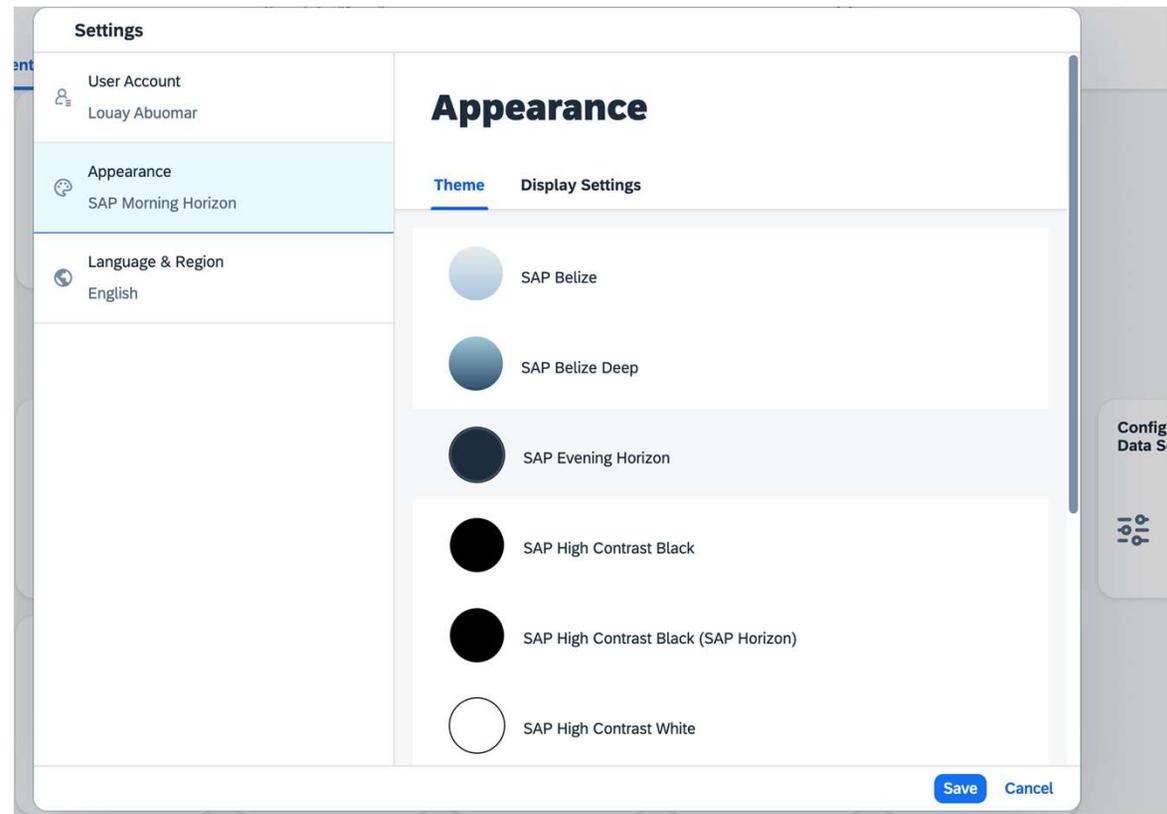


# 4 Fiori Horizon as default user interface theme [CIM-681]

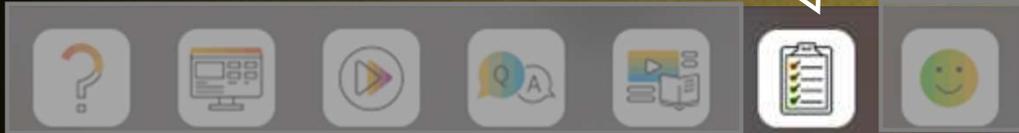
