CoE, EPS, and EPL are now using the SAP Business Network

The information below is time-sensitive and action is required.

The City of Edmonton (CoE), Edmonton Police Service (EPS), and Edmonton Public Library are improving and automating their procurement, invoice and payment management processes using SAP Business Network.

This transition is part of our initiative to enhance the efficiency and transparency of our operations. By implementing the SAP Business Network (Ariba), CoE, EPS, and EPL aim to optimize our transactions with suppliers, fostering stronger partnerships and ultimately providing better service to the community.

We will be ready to work with you in SAP Business Network, starting [Date - TBD]. This is your go-live date.

What does this mean for your company?

Effective [Date - TBD], the CoE, EPS, and EPL will conduct business with your company on the SAP Business Network to:

- Issue purchase orders (POs)
- Receive invoices

> Your company may need to create an SAP Business Network account

It's important to have only one account per supplier. Multiple users can be assigned to one account. If you already have an existing SAP Business Network account, you do not need to create another.

> Standard Account Information

A Standard Account is a free account and can also be created from the email invitation from your Buyer. When creating a standard account you will receive an interactive Purchase Order. With the Purchase Order open click on **Process Order**. Either 'Log In' to use an existing account or 'Sign Up' to create a new one (please see the **Helpful links** below).

> Update your company business contact payment information with the CoE, EPS, and EPL

We need to ensure we have to correct contact information on file to issue purchase orders (POs) and properly communicate payment information.

Your company's invoice address (remittance address) and Tax ID will be stored in your SAP Business Network account. In order to avoid any payment delays, please inform the CoE, EPS, or EPL of any changes to these fields immediately. This will allow us to update values in our system in order to avoid mismatched information.

> Notify others in your company about this change

The following processes in your business will be impacted: PO delivery, service entry sheets, invoice submission and payment remittance. Please forward this message to include others who need to know about the CoE, EPS and EPL's transition to using the SAP Business Network.

> Go-live

Prior to the go-live date, you will receive an email from the City reminding you of your go-live date of [Date - TBD].

Important Note: Over the coming months it is possible that some POs may be manual and others will be in SAP Business Network, as the CoE, EPS, and EPL's business areas also prepare to use SAP Business Network. Only POs sent on the SAP Business Network should be invoiced using the SAP Business Network.
