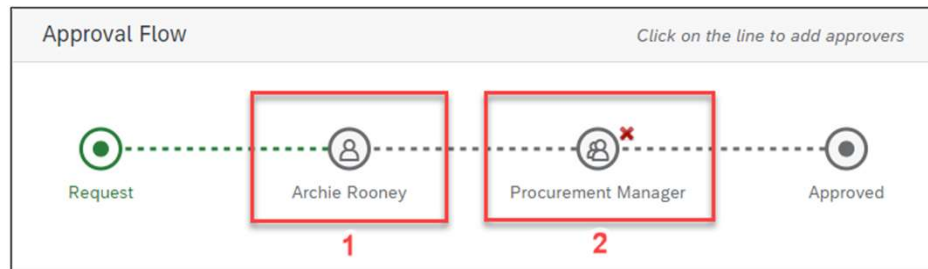
Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



Support for adding groups to requisition approval flows in guided buying [\[GB-24299\]](#)

Guided Buying users can add user groups to approval flows when they create purchase requisitions

- New icons in the approval flow show whether an approver is an individual user or a group (see screenshot below)
 - 1=Individual User; 2=Group
- **Prerequisites:** Administrators define user groups in SAP Ariba Procurement solutions
- **Restrictions:** Groups can be added to purchase requisitions only, not to other document type such as forms or invoices.
- **GA date:** 2311
- **Influence Request Delivery** (over 60 votes)





Mandatory Features

Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



Faster user interface response through optimized validation [\[GB-24841\]](#)

Guided Buying now speeds user interface response by validating only necessary requisition fields.

- It validates only those fields that are used in the *Expression* sheet in your validation policy, and only when users open a saved requisition for editing or click **Submit** in the **Checkout** page
- **Initial GA date:** 2402
- This feature is **automatically on through** the following parameter:
 - PARAM_ENABLE_REQUISITION_CONDITIONAL_EXECUTION



Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



Decommission Document Approval API Version 1 [\[PLAF-6918\]](#)

The Document Approval API Version 1 (V1) is decommissioned as of the Q3 2024 release. Version 2 is the active version of this API. You must update your client application to use the active version.

- Version 1 of this API was **deprecated in August, 2021**, when Version 2 became available. After this date, SAP Ariba continued supporting existing client applications that called Version 1.
- If you continue to use Version 1 after it is decommissioned you may see unexpected results and your client application will stop functioning.
- **Action required:** update API Calls to the Document Approval API **Version 2**



Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



Rate limits for external approval API for sourcing and supplier management version 2 [[SS-54380](#)]

Rate limits will be enforced on the External Approval API for Sourcing and Supplier Management version 2 (v2) so that the requests made using the API do not exceed the defined limit.

- The following rate limits will apply:
 - 20 requests per second
 - 400 requests per minute
 - 12000 requests per hour
 - 40000 requests per day
- **Initial GA date:** 2405
- **Action required:**
 - Please communicate these changes to your administrators and IT teams in your organization
 - Verify that rate limits are not exceeded as per the above limitations




Features becoming mandatory with 2408 release:



Disable reply-to header field [\[SS-50729\]](#)

This feature disables Reply-To fields in the email message sent by SAP Ariba

- Some buyer and supplier mail systems and spam filters may block email messages based on the address in the Reply-To field
- This enables buyer and suppliers to receive previously blocked email sent from SAP Ariba
- **Initial GA date:** 2311
- With 2408, the Intelligent Configuration Manager (ICM) parameter Include Reply-To header in email notifications (Application.ACM.Email.EnableReplyToHeader) will no longer be available and the software will perform as if this parameter is set to No.

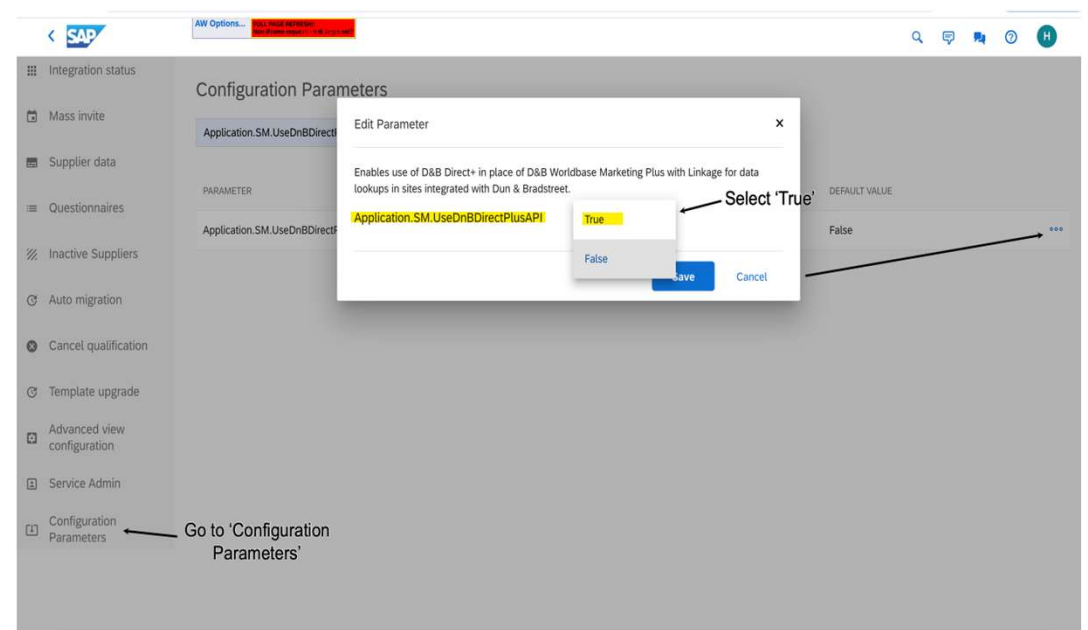
New Endpoint in Supplier Data API with Pagination to Extract Inactive Suppliers [SM-37338](#)

1 Dun & Bradstreet Integration Using D&B Direct+ SM-35214

This feature adds the option for using the newer Dun & Bradstreet's Direct+ product to retrieve data for selected fields in supplier requests and registrations. D&B Direct+ is the latest D&B offering, and SAP Ariba recommends that customers upgrade their D&B integrations to use it.

Benefits to customers:

- Helps customers to migrate to latest D&B offerings,
- Migration to Direct+ API from D&B
- Allows customers to continue their business using D&B capability with very minimal configuration



2 Enhancement and Best Practice Guide to Logging Audit History SM-43216

This feature will provide organizations the guidance to audit history of logging changes when their users "Act as" during registration updates. This also logs status (Active/Inactive) of the template changes.

Benefits to Customers:

- Guides customers to access audit log and history of changes for the questionnaire and customer is able to meet their audit requirements

3 Including Process Type Information in Response Body of vendorDataRequests Endpoint [SM-42813](#)

With this feature, the vendorDataRequests endpoint of the Supplier Data API with Pagination displays the exact process type in the disqualification information response when users disqualify a process. Influence Request [306084](#)

Benefits to Customers:

- will help customers using Supplier Data with pagination API to have accurate qualification information in external systems.

This feature adds a new endpoint `inactiveVendorRequests` in the Supplier Data API with Pagination. This endpoint allows you to retrieve the data of all the inactive and expired suppliers in your site. Influence Request [288557](#)

Benefits to Customers:

- A new Supplier data API endpoint that shall allow customers to extract the Inactive/Expired suppliers.

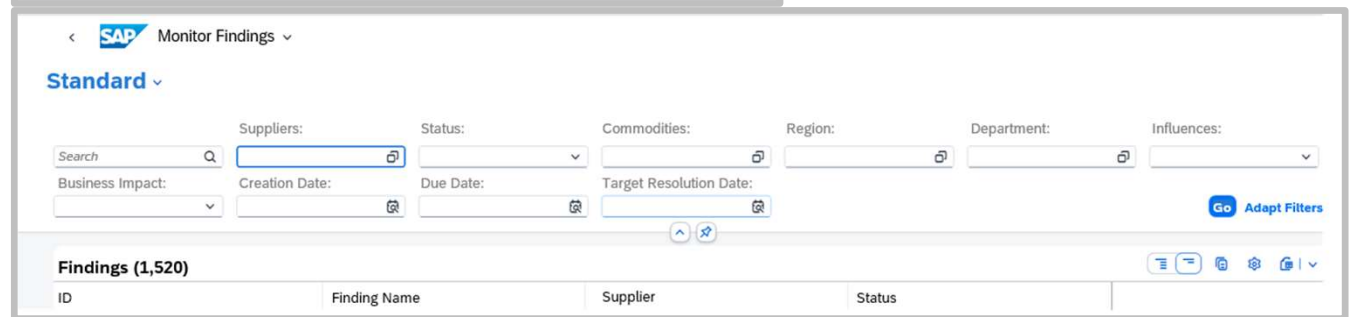
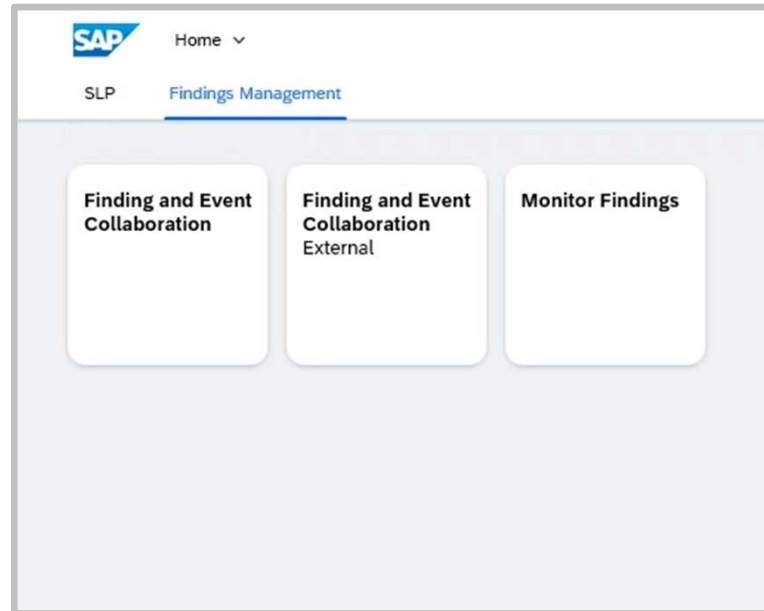

1 Monitor Findings for Findings and Event Collaboration NGSM-6184

New app allowing users to easily view and download reports on actions managed within finding and event collaboration

Benefits to Customers:

- Fiori report on BTP that enables reporting on Findings and Event Collaboration data based on various criteria including Status, Business Impact, Suppliers, Commodities, region, department, creation date, due date and target resolution date.



2 Supplier Risk administrative user permissions [ARI-20835](#)

Ability to delegate some of the administrative actions to new SAP Ariba Supplier Risk user groups. Four new user groups created with a set of permissions assigned to each of them.

Benefits to Customers:

- Helps customers with providing individual user permissions for different actions to be performed, thereby provides better monitoring and usage of resources.

User Group	Permission
Supplier Risk Evaluation Expert	Submit supplier information for risk evaluation
Supplier Risk Report Expert	Generate reports
Supplier Risk Provider Registration Expert	Register third-party providers
Supplier Risk Configuration Expert	Configure risk calculations of suppliers

This feature introduces an automated survey in SAP Ariba Supplier Risk to collect anonymous data about the user experience.
