

PunchOut Catalog: Tips and Tricks

To create a quality PunchOut catalog, remember the following:

- Use your company logo or images for product level catalogs
- Use a high level commodity code that best represents your range of products
- Ensure content hosted on your PunchOut site has rich descriptions, classification codes, images, etc.
- Make sure your PunchOut catalog can support the Create/Edit/Inspect cXML operations
- Support customer specific pricing
- Future-proof your PunchOut catalog for any future development and customer needs (think about the long term)
 - This might involve being able to support custom fields for customers
 - Mapping your commodity codes to UNSPSC codes where applicable
- Don't hesitate to explore PunchOut Level 2 capabilities
- Ensure your PunchOut catalog does not generate any additional extra work for you or your customer when ordering
- Explore options to integrate your SAP Business Network account with your backend system for more efficient order and invoicing processes
