Ability to navigate from SAP Business Network Global Track and Trace standard apps' detail pages to the individual source documents in SAP S/HANA with a single click:

- Freight orders
- Freight bookings
- Freight units
- Sales orders
- Purchase orders (including stock transfer orders)
- Outbound deliveries
- Inbound Deliveries

To achieve this, you need to configure the corresponding url in the System Connection app.


If I found discrepancies in tracking apps, I need to navigate to the corresponding source document in S/4HANA, so that I can make some changes, for example:

Feature Details

How can I configure to URL

To achieve this, you need to go to the 'System Connection' app:

1. "Add New Connection"

Click "Add" button and add a new connection with

- Connection Type: ABAP-based SAP System
- Connection ID: Logical System (e.g. QV8CLNT910)
- System ID: Logical System (e.g. QV8CLNT910, the same as Connection ID)




2. "Configure Document Link"

Click "Configure Document Links" button on the top right corner, and fill with

- Logical System Name: Logical System (e.g. QV8CLNT910, the same as Connection ID in step 1)
- Document Type: Select the type for tracked process you want to configure, e.g. TM Freight Order
- Base URL: The base URL of your TM system, e.g. <https://igc201-qv8910.wdf.sap.corp>
- Path*: The path to the tracked process e.g. /sap/bc/ui5_ui5/ui2/ushell/shells/abap/FioriLaunchpad.html?sap-language=EN#FreightOrder-display
- Parameter: Optional. Specify them here if any parameter is required. E.g. Name: ID, Value: {{trackingId}}

3. "Navigation"

Once all the above configurations are completed, go to the fulfillment apps and open the corresponding tracked process that you configured, then click the  button on the top right corner to navigate to the source system. (The document link will take effect up to 15 minutes after configuration if model cache is turned on.)

Appendix A – Suggested Configurations for Document Links (1/2)

Base URL is the FLP URL. It is the same for all the documents in the same logical system.

- “https://igc201-qv8910.wdf.sap.corp” is an example for an ERP system where system ID is QV8 and client is 910

Path and Parameters differ for different document types, here are some recommendations:

- TM Freight Order:

Path: /sap/bc/ui5_ui5/ui2/ushell/shells/abap/FioriLaunchpad.html#FreightOrder-display

Parameters: Name = ID, Value = {{trackingId}}

- TM Freight Booking:

Path: /sap/bc/ui5_ui5/ui2/ushell/shells/abap/FioriLaunchpad.html#FreightBooking-display

Parameters: Name = ID, Value = {{trackingId}}

- TM Freight Unit:

Path: /sap/bc/ui5_ui5/ui2/ushell/shells/abap/FioriLaunchpad.html#FreightBooking-display

Parameters: Name = ID, Value = {{trackingId}}
